PRE-EVENT TRAINING OPTIONS

To assist MNAs and their athletes to excel at Perth 2011, the organisers have developed a comprehensive list of pre-Event training options.

Whilst not the direct responsibility of Perth 2011, pre-Event training is a crucial part of athlete preparation and the organisers are keen to facilitate the best possible training options for MNAs.

Perth 2011 intends to deliver the best possible ISAF Sailing World Championships and having acclimatised and prepared athletes will be a key element in delivery on that intention.

MNAs are encouraged to enter the Sail Down Under Series, a series of graded regattas on the east coast of Australia including Sail Sydney and culminating in Sail Melbourne, the first leg of the ISAF Sailing World Cup.

Locally, MNAs have a number of options for pre-Event training from 1 October 2011:

- Fremantle Sailing Club
- Royal Perth Yacht Club Annexe Fremantle
- Woodman's Point Recreation Camp & Cockburn Power Boat Association
- Jervoise Bay Sailing Club
- Public Car Park at Woodman's Point Boating precinct
- Other Western Australian yacht clubs

Each of these options has unique features and are priced accordingly.

MNAs requiring a training venue for their own Elliot 6 yachts for their Women's Match Racing team have the following options:

- Royal Freshwater Bay Yacht Club (RFBYC)
- Perth Flying Squadron Yacht Club
- Royal Perth Yacht Club
- South of Perth Yacht Club

It should be noted that teams are NOT permitted to train or sail on the Harbour Course but a training course has been established adjacent to the RFBYC and is specified in the Notice of Race.

Once MNAs have confirmed their booking for pre-Event training, they are requested to advise Perth 2011 of their booking so that Perth 2011 can ensure that all are catered for and that athletes will have a clear understanding of the arrangements.

The ISAF Sailing World Cup, "Sail Melbourne" hosted at Sandringham Yacht Club, 6-12 November 2011, offers the perfect training ground for teams/individuals to compete against the best-of-the-best at a world-class international regatta, prior to Perth 2011.

"Sail Melbourne" will shortly be releasing details regarding a logistics solution that will make it easy and inexpensive for competitors to transport their boats and equipment from Melbourne to Perth 2011.

Last year's "Sail Melbourne" brought together 456 athletes from 42 countries, including a host of world champions and Olympic gold medalists. The impressive field included the likes of Ben Ainslie, Tom Slingsby, Malcolm Page, Matt & Friederike Belcher, Nick Thompson and Stuart McNay. They look forward to once again welcoming an impressive lineup of competitors to this year's event.

With the final race of the 2011 ISAF Sailing World Cup series taking place in June this year why not take full advantage of an additional competition at a world class regatta. The excellent sailing conditions on Port Phillip Bay coupled with an Olympic level race management team and state of the art facilities, makes Melbourne one of the best regarded Olympic class sailing events on the circuit.

FREMANTLE SAILING CLUB

Fremantle Sailing Club is one of Australia's largest yacht clubs, located within the Perth 2011 event precinct and within walking distance from central Fremantle. The Club is the host venue for the Men's and Women's One Person Dinghy Events (Laser and Laser Radial) and is centrally positioned to all Perth 2011 courses.

For pre-event training, the Club offers extensive lawns, launch ramps, and convenient bathroom and shower facilities for athletes.

Function rooms, plus restaurant and bar facilities are available for team meetings and social events. On-site workshop container and support boat storage is also available.

Fremantle Sailing Club welcomes all officials and athletes to visit the club during the Event to enjoy the social scene, restaurant and bar.

Access to Fremantle Sailing Club is available from 1 October 2011 until 26 November 2011. The club has a capacity for 250 yachts, 50 support boats and 8 containers for pre-Event training.

ROYAL PERTH YACHT CLUB FREMANTLE ANNEXE

The Royal Perth Yacht Club Fremantle Annexe is centrally located to all Perth 2011 course areas. It is Western Australia's oldest yacht club, established in 1853. Its main club is near Perth on the Swan River Estuary, located 12km directly north east from Fremantle. The Annexe was built for the 1986/87 America's Cup Defence. It is a comparatively small marina, but has installed a 6m ramp for dinghies and has limited hardstand space. A larger temporary ramp will be installed for Perth 2011 to extend it to 24 metres in total. It has two fixed pillar cranes suitable for Star class yachts and support boats.

Access to RPYC Annexe is available from 1 October 2011 until 26 November 2011. The club has a capacity for 60 yachts and 20 support boats during pre-Event training.

 \$20.00 per support boat per day

Royal Perth Yacht Club Annexe is unable to receive containers of any size (for unloading or storage) or road trailers (support boats and Stars included). Containers and trailers can be stored free of charge at the Perth 2011 storage facility at Leighton located at (32° 01.8"S, 115°45.8"E).

WOODMAN'S POINT RECREATION CAMP AND COCKBURN POWER BOAT ASSOCIATION

Woodman's Point Recreation Camp is operated by the WA Government's Department of Sport and Recreation and is a large site located adjacent to Owen Course and some 8km directly south of Fremantle (32° 7.6"S, 115°45.1"E).

Although the buildings are of historical significance and heritage listed, they house state of the art recreation facilities and a modern camp site. The site boasts 240 beds in a range of accommodation options suitable for larger groups and includes an exclusive catering service. Perth 2011 has secured access to the 'day area' to provide toilet, shower, BBQ, fitness and meeting/briefing facilities for teams staying offsite.

The protected beach is accessed via a 90m paved pathway and is very calm, even when the famous "Fremantle Doctor" sea breeze is blowing. The site has wash down facilities and two very large lawn areas with a separate secure compound and space for workshop containers.

The Woodman's Point facility with its large array of accommodation and direct access to the Perth 2011 course areas is ideal for Lasers but can easily accommodate 470s, Finns and RS:X boards.

Support boats can't be launched or berthed at Woodman's Point Recreation Camp so Perth 2011 has made arrangements for support boats to be launched, berthed and stored at the adjacent Cockburn Power Boat Association. The Association has a small marina and boats can be launched by vehicle via any of the five boat ramps. The Cockburn site has full clubhouse facilities and comprehensive security.

Access is available for 1 October 2011 onwards and the combined sites have a capacity for 250 yachts, 50 support boats and 5 containers during pre-Event training.

JERVOISE BAY SAILING CLUB

Jervoise Bay Sailing Club is a small sailing club located adjacent to Owen Course and some 8km directly south of Fremantle (32° 7.59"S, 115°44.56"E).

Although the club buildings are very modest and open, it boasts new toilet and shower facilities and a new boat ramp overlooking a protected beach, ideal for launching dinghies of all kinds. JBSC is a registered campsite and can provide some 15 medium sized tents for those requiring accommodation.

The beach is protected and very calm, even when the famous "Fremantle Doctor" sea breeze is blowing and provides stunning views of the course areas. The site has wash down facilities and a large lawn area with two separate hardstand compounds, each with fences and locked gates. Support boats can be launched via the boat ramp with a vehicle or from the nearby Woodman Point Public ramps adjacent to the Cockburn Power Boat Association.

JBSC will be the host club for the Australian 49er National Championships, most likely to be conducted on the 25-27 November by The Cruising Yacht Club of WA (contact details next page). The regatta, the vast lawn space and flat water make this site ideal for 49er teams.

Access to Jervoise Bay Sailing Club is available from 1 October 2011 onwards and the club has capacity for 100 yachts, 30 support boats and 5 containers during pre-Event training.

PUBLIC CAR PARK AT WOODMAN'S POINT

There is a free public car park and multiple launching ramps located at the Woodman's Point boating precinct (32° 8.2'S, 115°45.5"E). Whilst this facility is unsecured and has complete public access, it is available any time and has a fenced area capable of handling hundreds of yachts at no cost. From here it is only a short sail around Woodman's Point to Owen Course.

Access to the Fremantle Inner Harbour is under 3 bridges, the lowest having a clearance of 6.1m. The offered training area as per the Notice of Race is located approximately 7 nautical miles from Centre Course.
