27	13-Jul-11	CHI (athlete)	We're shipping our boat and rib from Hamburg to Sydney. We need documents to present to the customs in Australia for a temporary import and I was hoping you could help us with that issue. Is there any assistance the organisation is giving?	<i>More information can be found through DB Schenker on the Freight and Logistics page on the Perth2011.com website. The best option is to get an ATA Carnet from your Chamber of Commerce. Failing that, you need to apply to Perth2011 to use our Security number. We would need further information as follows - Your name, your team and country details, details of all of the equipment to be shipped, it's value and confirmation you will be taking the items out of Australia after the Perth2011 event is finished. Once approved you will need to provide our security number to your freight forwarding agent who will then include it with the necessary documentation.</i>
26	29-Jun-11	ESP	The NoR informs that containers and trailers can be stored at The Leighton Storage Yards (free of charge from 1 Oct.2011). The thing is, we have been trying to find it on the maps but without success. Could you please provide me with some sort of plan or map where its location is clear for us?	<i>The coordinates of the Leighton secure storage site is: 32.0200 degrees South, 115.7522 degrees East. 25	27-Jun-11	JPN	In regards to the coach boat berths, can we use this berth from November 25 till the end of the ISAF Worlds? For example, we entered 8 events. Can we enter 8 support boats and keep them afloat from Nov 25 till Dec 18? Can we use Laser coach boat as well to the Laser Radial (means two coach boats go to the Laser Radial course as Laser does not start until after the Radial). As we have not seen the coach boat regulations yet, please advise how to calculate the days of floating space. We need that information in order to set up the numbers of coach boats to container shipping.	<i>The support boat fee covers the use of these moorings from 29th Nov to 19th Dec with a shuttle service to and from the moorings. Although the moorings may be available before this date, there will not be a shuttle service until the 29th Nov. No problem to use more than one of your coach boats for the same class. See Communique # 3 - Pre-Event Training Options listing a number of yacht clubs/locations for storage options before these dates. Although you are allocated 1 support boat berth per event these boats can be used in first week and also second week</i>
24	2-May-11	ISR	Please advice when is the earliest day that we can be with our Container of Boats at your location in Perth?	<i>See also Q 23. The Perth 2011 container storage facility will be open from October 1st, 2011 please refer to page 15, Notice of Race .Addendum C</i>

23	27-Jun-11	JPN	We make a request for possible berthing/mooring place for our support boats prior to Perth 2011 ISAF Sailing World Championships. Japan Sailing Team will be competing in the London 2012 Olympic Test Event in Weymouth, UK in August, and after the event, we plan to directly send our 2 RIB boats to Perth from UK, as we may not have enough time to send them to Japan and then to Perth. We will most likely be using DB Schenker for logistics, but since the boats are likely to arrive in Perth around early October, we would need a place to keep our boats for about 2 months until the Championships	<p>Containers arriving early before the teams can be stored. However the following needs to be noted:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Teams must complete unloading of containers for Australian Quarantine & Inspection Service (AQIS) inspections. Should you require DB Schenker to unpack the container additional fees will be charged for this and the Team must also sign an indemnity form, removing DB Schenker from any liability should damage occur. • Shipping lines only give 10 free days detention from 1st day container is available at the port. Detention (storage in a AQIS/Customs approved secure storage yard) is then charged per/day per/cntr thereafter. • We will try to obtain extra free days until teams arrive but there is no guarantee. • There will be additional costs for transport of container/s ex holding yard to AQIS unpack/inspection yard. • Please check with local DB Schenker rep for clarification and costs for the above.
22	27-Jun-11	THA	NOR 4.1 states that fee for support boat is AUD 150. Does it mean that apart from paying the fee to charter support boat from one of the companies listed in Communique # 5 we need to pay an additional fee of AUD 150 to use the berth?	Yes, correct. Each MNA will be offered one priority support boat berth per Event in which the MNA has at least one confirmed entry by the 31 July 2011. These priority berths must be confirmed and paid for by 31 July 2011.
21	31-May-11	EST	Is it possible to have our own Laser boats in the Boat Park for training until we receive the racing boats for Worlds? The sailor wants to use his boat for training and rent the racing boat only for racing dates and not for the pre-event dates.	See question #12 from BRA 6 April 2011. As stated in NOR 7.9, only supplied equipment and additional equipment as listed in the Equipment Inspection Regulations is allowed in the Boat Park. Use of your own equipment for pre-event training is OK - but cannot be out of the Laser Boat Park. Pre-event training information is detailed in Communique #3.
20	30-May-11	THA	I refer to NOR 20 – Insurance which stated that: “Each ‘person in charge’ shall hold a valid insurance certificate showing proof of third-party liability coverage of at least 10,000,000 Australian Dollars (or equivalent) per incident, valid for Australian waters.” Is it possible for THA athletes to buy such insurance coverage at the venue? If so, how much would it cost?	Yes - it is possible to purchase the third party liability Insurance pre event, online, through a form that is posted on the Perth2011 website under Athletes/Entry tab. The cost of the third party liability insurance is AUD \$104.75
19	23-May-11	MAS	We would like to have the information about Int 470 Charter as we will take part in this event. Kindly advise us if you can provide us the boat for charter in that period. Hope to hear from you soon. Thank you.	It is near impossible to find an internationally competitive 470 in Perth available for charter. Suggest you try Australian 470 Class Association through the links on the international 470 association website

This information would greatly assist us in the planning process for training locations. 15	14-Apr-11	NZL	With the Challenger boat park (RSX), apparently there was a very narrow launching area/ramp last year (Lasers), are there any contingencies to address this for 2012?	<i>The boat ramp from Challenger boat park to the Bathers Beach is heritage listed and cannot be modified. There are steps down to the beach, as well as the ramp.</i>
14	14-Apr-11	NZL	With the RS:X's Men and Women's racing different weeks, for those classes racing in the second week (R: SX M), are there any training area restrictions for the RS:X M while the RS:X W are racing?	<i>Yes - the RS:X Boat Park/Bathers Beach will have restricted access for launching and retrieval of RS:X M when the Centre Course is being activated. There is a training area set aside off the Fremantle Sailing Club (old South Beach Course area), to the south of Centre Course</i>
13	8-Apr-11	CYP	We would appreciate if you could advise which classes will be in which course area.	<i>See Communique #4 on the perth2011.com website</i>
12	6-Apr-11	BRA	The charter boats for the pre event period of Laser Standard and Laser Radial will be available since which date at the Official Event Boat Park?	<i>Boat Parks open from 29th November as in the NoR. Pickup for pre event charter for the Laser Radial is from 26th November and for the Laser from 2nd December. Please note: ONLY supplied equipment will be allowed into the Laser boat park (see NoR 7.9).</i>
11	4-Apr-11	NZL	Would you know of a suitable gym the New Zealand team could use while in Fremantle training for the worlds?	<i>Fremantle Leisure Centre (+61 8 9432 9533)/ Warehouse Fitness Centre (+61 8 9335 7333) & others</i>

Full information on pre-event training and Australian lead up events will be available on the Perth 2011 website and will be sent to all MNAs by 1st April 2011.</i>
5	3-Mar-11	BRA	When are we able to enter/register our athletes online and can I change the details if needed?	<i>Registration for each athlete/team can be made on the Perth2011 online registration on the Perth2011 website on or before 1st August 2011. It will have a function to edit details up until 18th November 2011.</i>
4	1-Mar-11	ISR	What accommodation options are available in Fremantle, we would like to find a self-contained house.	<i>Fremantle is largely booked out. However, we suggest that you visit the Perth 2011 website, where there are links to our Official Supplier, Qantas Holidays' website. There is also a wide range of accommodation including hotel, bed and breakfast, self-contained units/houses, backpackers accommodation, caravan parks etc. Links to these can also be found on the Perth 2011 website.
