COMMUNIQUE # 16 – PRE EVENT TRAINING UP DATE

October 4th, 2011

Dear Participant,

Communiqué 3 issued on the 3rd May 2011 entitled “Pre Event Training Options” advised teams that they would need to make arrangements with one of the listed venues if they intended to train prior to the Boat Parks opening.

Many MNAs have now done so but we would advise that the two Fremantle venues of Fremantle Sailing Club and Royal Perth Yacht Club Annexe are now **fully booked**.

There is still plenty of room at the other options namely;

- Woodman’s Point Recreation Camp & Cockburn Power Boat Association
- Jervoise Bay Sailing Club
- Other Western Australian Sailing Clubs

If you plan to arrive and train prior to the Boat Parks opening on 29th November it will be necessary for you to book one of these venues before you arrive in Perth so that you will have a secure place to move your equipment to after it has been cleared by Customs and Quarantine.
