COMMUNIQUE # 20 – TRANSPORT AROUND FREMANTLE

October 31st, 2011

Dear Participant,

This is important information to assist you in relation to transport around Fremantle during your stay for the Perth 2011 ISAF Sailing World Championships. Perth 2011 has implemented some initiatives to assist athletes and teams in moving around venues during the Event.

Parking

Parking within Fremantle is limited and most of it is paid parking. Perth 2011 has provided dedicated parking for cars and mini-buses at Wilson Park just south of the Fremantle Sailing Club. Athletes and Team officials can park here daily for free. A free CAT bus (public transport) operates past this location every 10mins and a dedicated free Perth 2011 shuttle operates from 0800 to 2000. You can catch both buses from stop 12 on the Shuttle map.

If you choose to park elsewhere, please ensure you park in marked bays only and follow the signs otherwise you could receive an infringement notice.

Perth 2011 iiNet Shuttle

A free Perth 2011 shuttle will operate from 0800-2000 from 29 Nov to 19 Dec. The iiNet Shuttle will be clearly marked and all stops will have appropriate signage.



Getting Around Fremantle

The best way to get around Fremantle will be by bicycle. Paths exist between the main regatta venues and bicycles will be able to navigate through the road closures on peak days. Perth 2011 is providing bicycle parking at each of the Boat Parks and outside the Regatta Office. There are also numerous other public bike parking locations throughout Fremantle.

If you haven't already packed your bicycle into the container with your boat, Perth 2011 has organised Bicycle Hire through one of our Official Suppliers, Rottnest Express. Details below:

Bicycle Hire available between Saturday 19th November and Sunday 18th December directly from the Rottnest Express office at B Shed, Victoria Quay (right next to the Inner Harbour Course for Women's Match Racing). Price includes a multi-gear bicycle, helmet, lock & chain and a map. Prices as follows:

Day rate	\$28.00/day
Week rate	\$86.00/week
Two week rate	\$172.00/two weeks
Additional weeks	\$35.00/week (above two weeks)
