## COMMUNIQUE # 21 – WORKSHOP CONTAINERS

November 1st, 2011

Dear Participant,

This is important information to assist you in planning the logistics of your Workshop Container.

The Perth 2011 Organising Committee has made arrangements to store Team's Workshop Containers in a central location in Fremantle during the World Championships. Teams are limited to one container per Team.

A Workshop Container can be either a 20 foot or 40 foot standard shipping container. It may be a sophisticated container equipped with work benches, power, lighting, power tools etc. or may simply be a privately owned or leased container that an MNA uses to store gear.

Teams who wish to arrange storage of a Workshop Container at a Perth 2011 storage facility need to book storage space with Perth 2011 before **16<sup>th</sup> November**. Perth 2011 has two locations - one in Mews road and if this becomes full, an overflow facility can be activated at Slip Street.

Perth 2011 will not be responsible for the costs of transporting the container to or from the facility but otherwise will provide the storage free of charge. Containers need to be loaded in by the 29<sup>th</sup> November and will not be able to be loaded out until the 19<sup>th</sup> December.

Some containers may require power. Perth 2011 will provide local 240V 50 Cycle AC power sufficient to run a few lights or power tools if required.

If an MNA needs a different type of power (e.g. 110V) it will need to make its own arrangements.

The power will be provided free, however, if an MNA wishes to run heavy equipment such as air conditioners or freezers a charge of \$10 a day will be levied.


